Referred by the Work Orientation and Placement Scheme of the Selective Placement Division of the Labour Department, I joined Caritas as Programme Worker II in February 2016. Being my first job, I was not in full confidence due to my physical disability.

To assist Suet Yee to integrate into the team and support her at work, the nurse supervisor acted as her instructor and the Programme Worker I as her peer tutor.

To enhance Suet Yee's self-confidence, we started from simple assignments such as document filing and answering phone calls, then paper cutting, lamination and computer input etc. We gradually found Suet Yee's capability is no different from the others. Suet Yee provided IT support for the Centre's participation in 5-S Certification. The Programme Worker I also coached her to lead group activities.

We are more confident in working with disabled employees after working with Suet Yee. In September 2016, our organisation launched the "Navigation Scheme" and recruited Ka Ho as Care Assistant on a First-Hire-Then-Train basis.

I had stroke when I was young and it affected the mobility of my right body. When I first joined the Centre, I was not used to the team's working procedures. Fortunately, the team supervisor kept coaching and encouraging me.

I was impressed by the teammates, including Suet Yee, who all encouraged me when I was upset.

The Center has successfully employed two persons with disabilities for more than a year. Their performance is no different from the others.

The nurse supervisors and Programme Worker I assisted Suet Yee when she first joined the Centre. We keep communicating with her to see if she encounters any difficulties or pressure at work.

Ka Ho is coached by the nurses on nursing skills. Our Centre staff accept and get along well with Suet Yee and Ka Ho.

Persons with disabilities are new work force for the elderly service. From our experience of employing persons with disabilities, it only took some time to get to know their abilities at the beginning in order to assign them with suitable tasks. Once they adapt to the job, they can work independently and wholeheartedly. They treasure the employment opportunities.
