

Hong Kong residents (including eligible persons with disabilities) aged 60 or above must apply for JoyYou Card to enjoy \$2 Scheme

Each eligible applicant will only be issued with one JoyYou Card

Existing Anonymous Elder Octopus and ordinary Personalised Octopus will not be covered under Scheme

- The existing Anonymous Elder Octopus and ordinary Personalised Octopus will not be covered under the \$2 Scheme. Eligible beneficiaries must use JoyYou Card¹ or Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status"² to enjoy the \$2 Scheme in future. Hong Kong residents (including eligible persons with disabilities) aged 60 or above should apply for a JoyYou Card as soon as possible if they do not have one.
 - ¹ JoyYou Card is applicable to Hong Kong residents (including eligible persons with disabilities) aged 60 or above
- ² Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" is applicable to eligible persons with disabilities aged below 60
- There is an expiry date for the "Persons with Disabilities Status" encoded on the Personalised Octopus of eligible persons with disabilities. Eligible persons with disabilities aged 60 or above have no need to apply for renewal of the "Persons with Disabilities Status" after switching to a JoyYou Card.
- Eligible persons with disabilities aged below 60 can continue to enjoy the \$2 Scheme using the Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status". Card replacement is not required.

How to apply for a JoyYou Card



Via Octopus App

By posting the application form

Applicants should send the completed application form with a copy of their Hong Kong identity card and a 1.5 x 2 inch colour passport photo (with white or plain light colour background) taken within six months by post to the address specified on the application form. JoyYou Card will be mailed to the correspondence address in Hong Kong given by eligible applicants within four weeks upon receipt of the required information and documents.

Application Fee

- The HKSAR Government subsidises the administrative fee for the first application of eligible beneficiaries.
- No activation of JoyYou Card is required. It can be used after topping up with an amount higher than HK\$50 via Octopus add-value channels. The initial top-up amount will include a refundable deposit of HK\$50.


